This September event, called Mission Café and Bakery, will replace Dakota Marketplace. Join us for lunch at Southern Hills UMC in Sioux Falls (3400 E 49th Street) on Saturday, September 24 from 11:00 a.m.-1:30 p.m. There will be a variety of food stations, a bakery, live entertainment, silent auction, craft fair and activities for children!

The Asbury Mission Team has volunteered to do a salad bar for one of the food stations. We'll also provide people to work in the dining room assisting guests and cleaning tables. The Craft Fair is open to anyone who would like to make and donate handcrafted items. We have reserved a table for our donations. Watch for details coming soon!

ALL proceeds from the Mission Café and Bakery will be divided between these two projects:

- Dakotas Hunger Grants – Last year we distributed almost \$19,000 to 14 programs serving hot meals in communities across the Dakotas.
- UMCOR World Hunger and Poverty Program - Through the World Hunger/

Poverty program, the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) not only supplies food for hungry people, but also

helps poor countries move forward with development. Seeds, tools and training are provided to enable people to grow their own food. This program combines immediate crisis relief (food, clothing and medical supplies) with long-term solutions (clean water, immunizations, enhanced agriculture and advocacy for appropriate public policies) to bring hope to people in despair. In the US, UMCOR assists states and communities through disaster relief efforts. And ALL donations go directly to the designated UMCOR project; there NO administrative costs applied to donations.
